IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

THE GRAND JURY, for the County of Van Zandt, State of Texas, duly selected impaneled, sworn, charged, and organized as such at the January Term A.D. 2010 of the 294th Judicial District Court for said County, upon their oaths present in and to said court at said term that **CHRIS SIVESTRO FANTICH** hereinafter styled Defendant, on or about October 1st, 2009, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there, with intent that aggravated assault, a felony be committed against Malcom Chakery, agree with Chance Lee Jenkins and a Confidential Human Source that they or one of them would engage in conduct that would constitute said offense, to-wit: causing bodily injury to Malcom Chakery requiring hospitalization by striking Malcom Chakery with a ball bat or cutting him with a razor or striking him with a pool stick, and the said Chance Lee Jenkins or Confidential Human Source performed an overt act in pursuance of said agreement, to-wit: traveling to Grand Prairie, Texas, the city in which Malcom Chakery lived, while in possession of a pool stick, **Against the peace and dignity of the State.**
